- Key points:
- Students have 2 weeks to complete their subject based homework projects once they are set.
 - Year 7 get one subject at a time
 - Year 8 get 2 subjects at a time (The two subjects have a skills or content link between them)
- Students are given 3 tasks to choose from they must complete at least 1.
- Each task has detail about what to include in it and how students can do well.
- Students get LOTS of feedback on how to become better at working independently (Homework) This is done by self reflection, peer marking and teacher marking.
- All work is given pride of place in our school displays.

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• Staff emails are included on homework tasks in case students or parents/carers need to ask any questions.

DAY 1

Homework is set in class, paper copies of the tasks are issued to every student and a whole lesson is spent planning out how to create an amazing piece of work, including looking at examples.

DAY 7

1 week after homework is set students bring in the work they have done so far. They are given feedback on how to improve their work and a chance to use arts and crafts materials and school laptops. 3 day lunch queue jump pass Winners Lanyard Celebration breakfast with subject and senior staff.

2 weeks after homework is set students must bring in a paper copy of their work (advice on printers is on homework sheet). During this lesson they self reflect on their work and peer assess their creation!
